Pre-Primer Nouns (95 words)

Sight words are words that early learners of English are encouraged to recognize by sight, rather than by sounding them out. Pre-primer sight word nouns are the basic nouns learned early in their reading. These include simple and familiar words like "dog," "cat," "man," and "sun." They are usually the first words early learners see in books and stories.
